

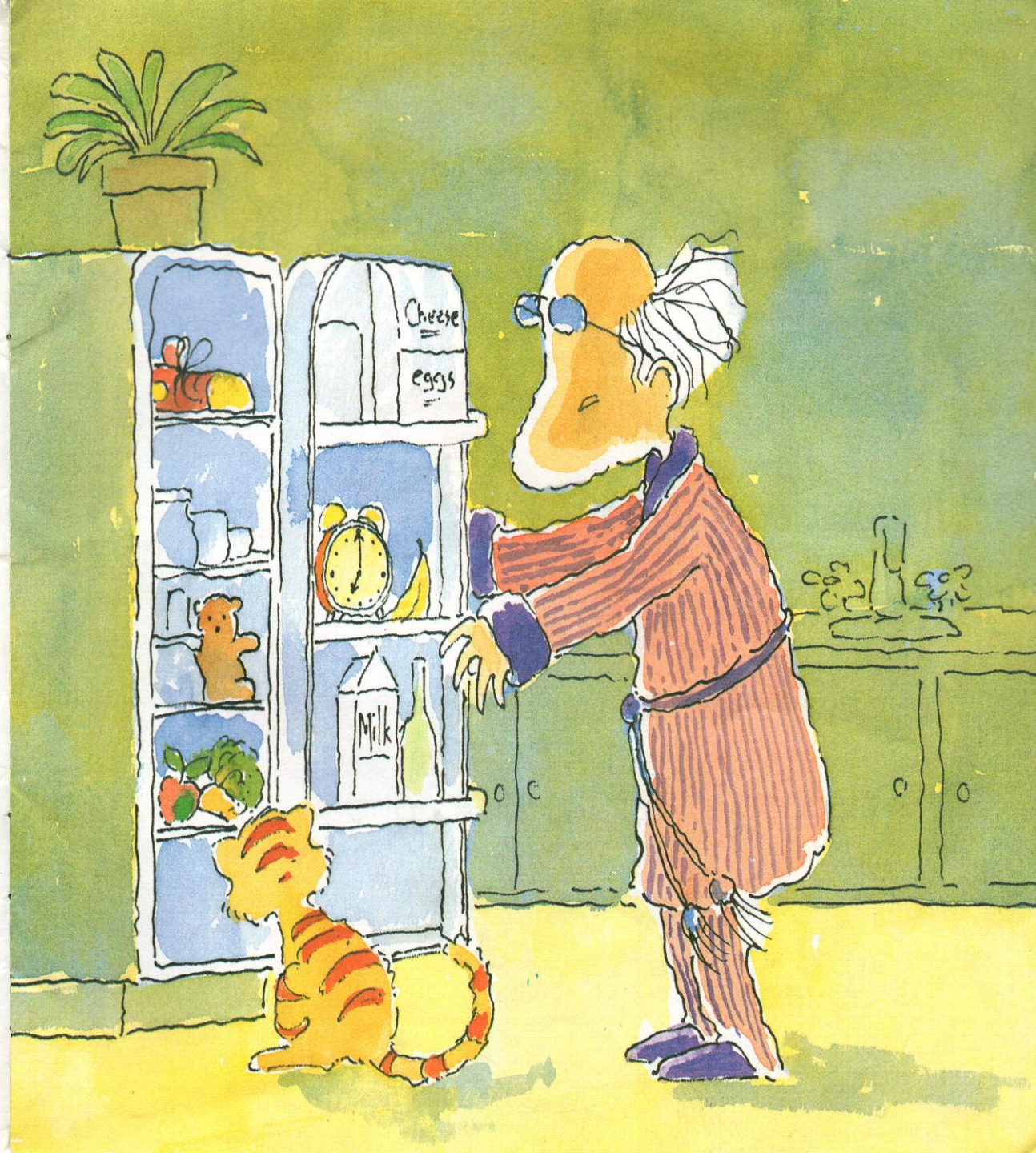

He looked all over the house.



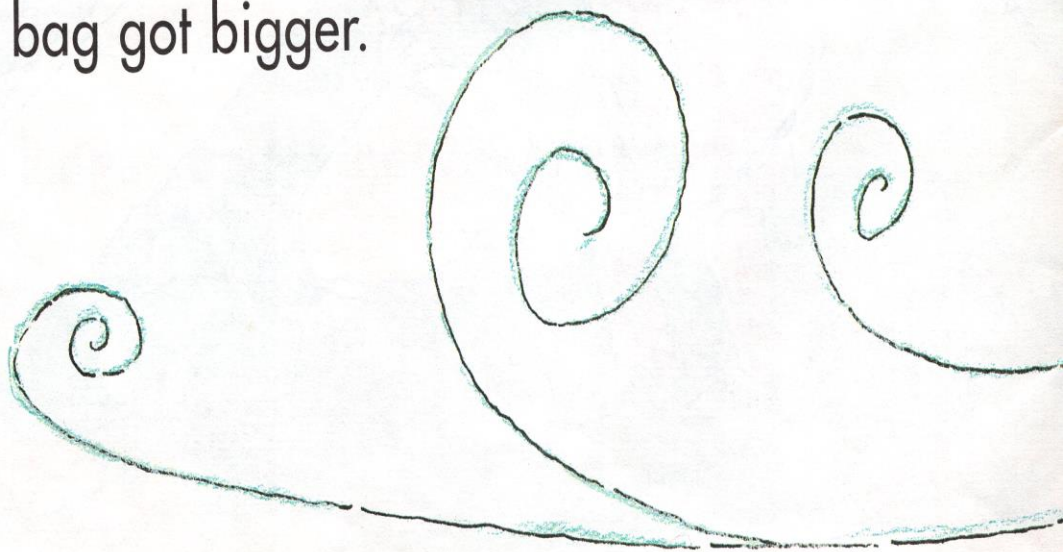
It was cleaning day.

He cleaned under the stairs and . . .

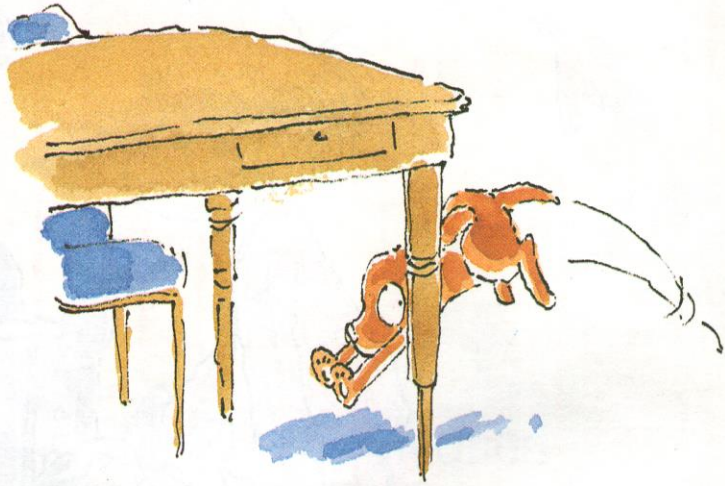


SLOOP! Up went a mouse.

under the bed and . . .





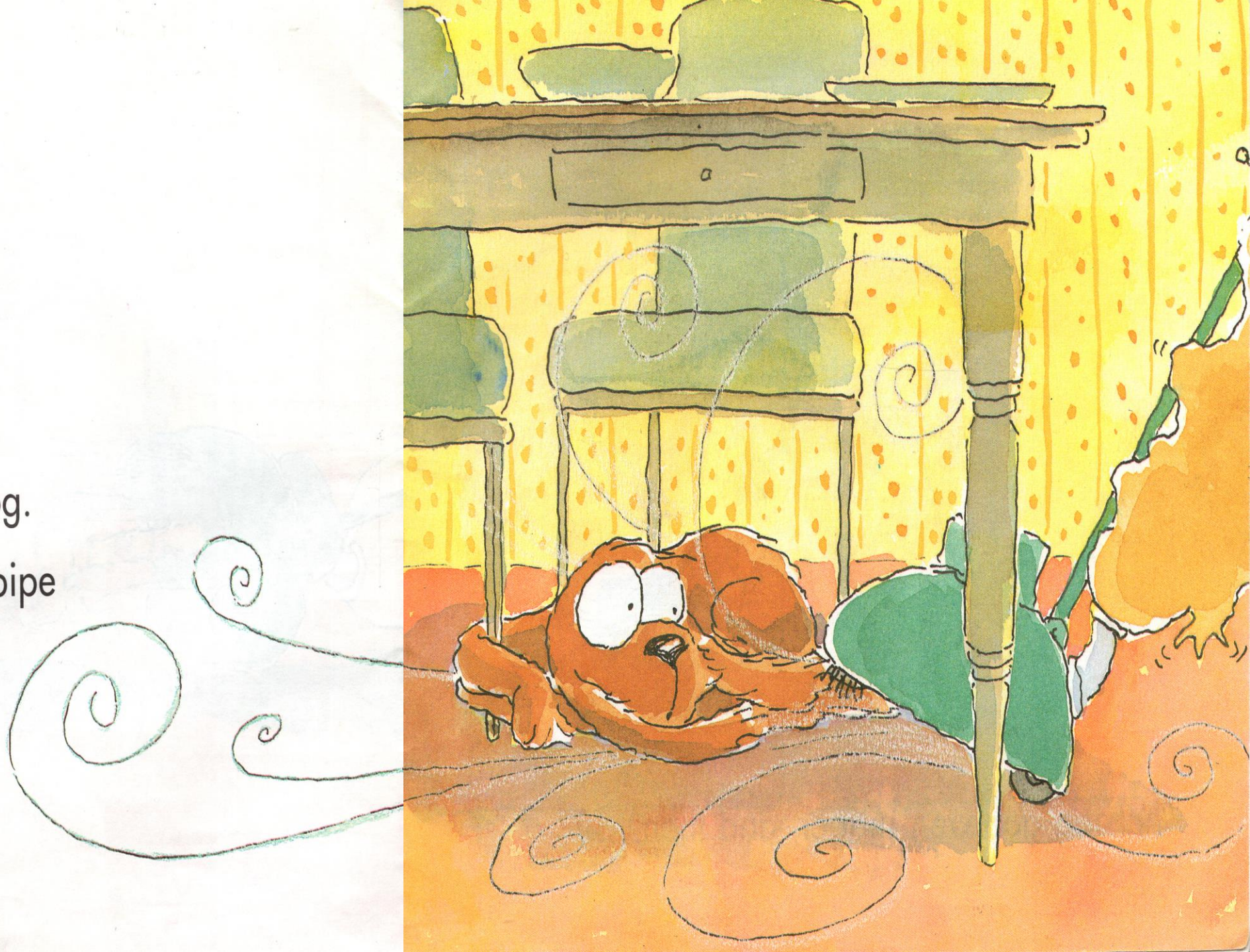
SLOOP! Up went the cat.

under the table and . . .

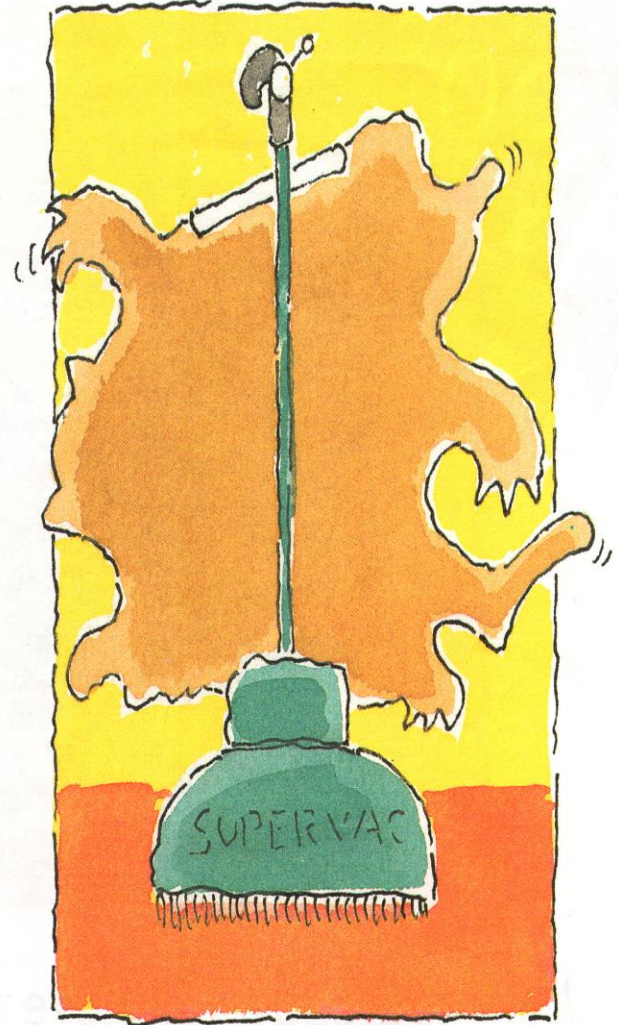
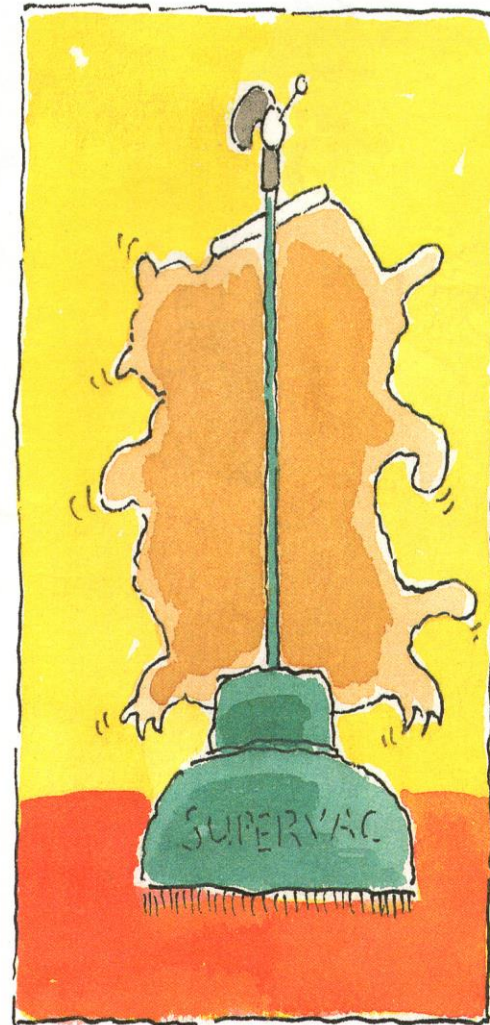
SLOOP! Up went the dog.

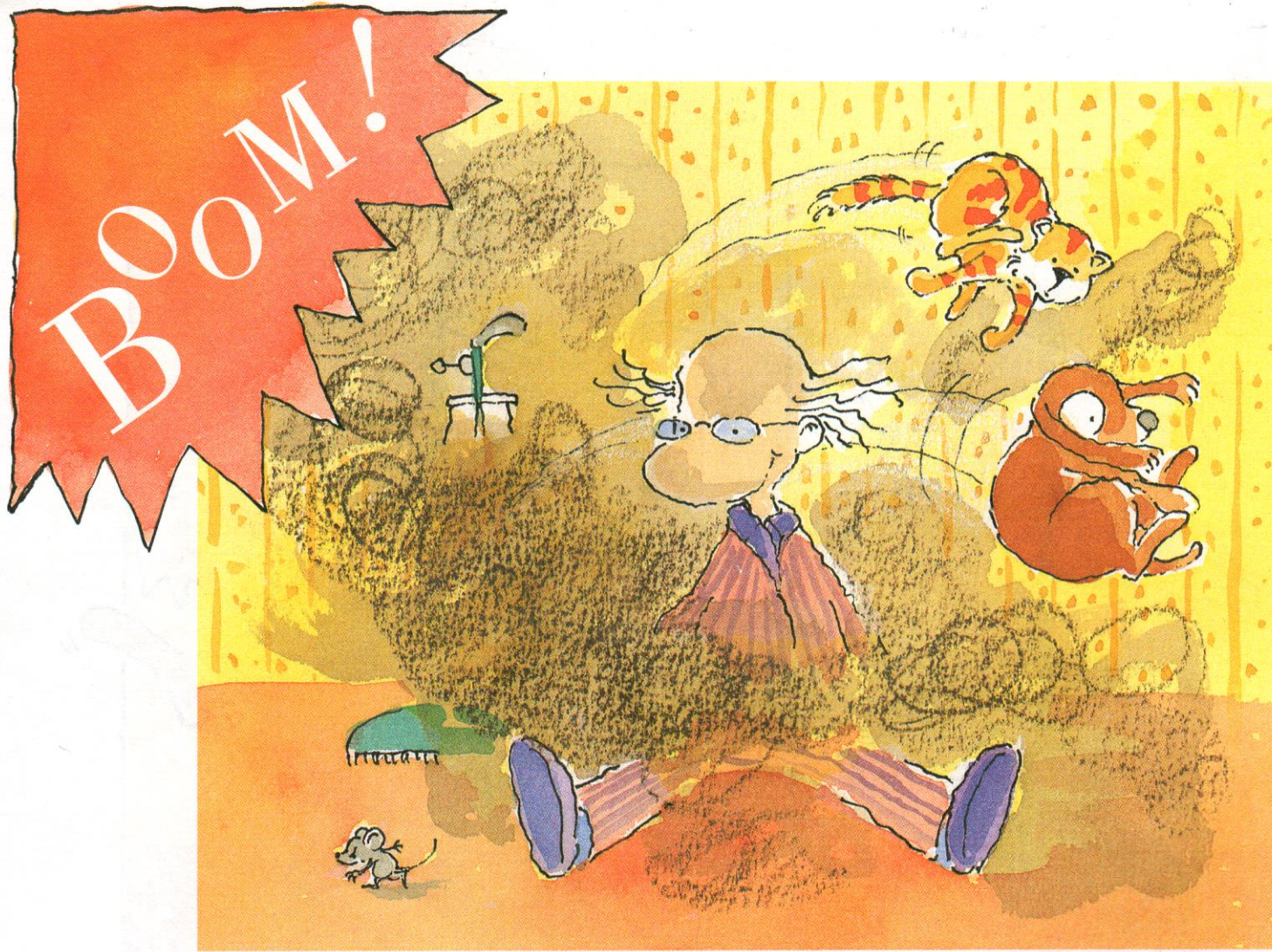
Up the hose, down the pipe
